Cleaning Instructions:

- Dry soil, Dust and Dirt, Dried on Dirt: Remove with a soft cloth dampened with water.
- Variation in Surface Gloss: Wipe with a soft cloth dampened with water. Allow to air dry.
- Stubborn Dirt: Wash with a soft cloth moistened with a mild soap and water. Rinse with clean water.
- Stubborn Spots and Stains: Spray with either Formula 409®, or Tannery Car Care Cleaner®, wiping with a soft cloth. Rinse with clean water.
- Liquid Spills: Wipe immediately with a clean absorbent cloth.
 Rinse with clean water.
- Food, Grease, and Oily Stains: Spray immediately using either Formula 409®, or Tannery Car Care Cleaner®, wiping with a soft cloth. Take care not to extend the area of contamination beyond its original boundary. Rinse with clean water.

Note: Vinyls should be periodically cleaned to maintain their appearance and prevent build-up of dirt and contaminates. Any stain, spill or soiling should be cleaned up promptly to prevent the possibility of permanent staining. When cleaning, always rub gently.

Caution: Powdered abrasives, abrasive cleaners, and steel wool damage vinyl, as do strong solvents, lacquer solvents and inks. Lotions, suntan oil, waxes and polishes, etc., contain oils and dyes that can cause stiffening and staining of vinyls. Never use heat guns or hair dryers.

Note: Stronger cleaners, detergents, and solvents may be effective in stain removal, but can cause either immediate damage or slow deterioration. The use of such cleaners is at the owner's own risk.





Disinfecting Guide:

Of the multiple disinfectants listed on the CDC's approved list the following disinfectants have been approved for use on Morbern coated fabric like Allante FRee® because they have shown to do minimal to no damage to the fabric when used appropriately.

- Dilute Bleach 9:1 ratio (10%)- Liberally apply diluted bleach solution using a sponge. Rinse with cold water several times. Wipe dry. Be sure to follow guidelines on the bleach label.
- Isopropyl Alcohol (70%)- Leave the 70% Isopropyl alcohol solution on the product for one minute. Follow with several clean water rinses before wiping dry.
- Hydrogen Peroxide (3%)- Apply product and allow to sit for one minute. Follow this with several clean water rinses before wiping dry.
- Other tested cleaners
 - Bleach-rite Disinfecting Spray With Bleach
 - Clorox Commercial Solutions® Hydrogen Peroxide Cleaner Disinfectant
 - Dispatch ® Hospital Cleaner Disinfectant Towels with Bleach

Important notes:

Cleaners/Disinfectants should only be used in the dilutions recommended by the manufacturer and never in concentrated form.

After each application, disinfectants should be thoroughly wiped off with clean water and dried with a clean towel. Any chemical residue left on a surface can cause discoloration and degradation to the surface of the fabric.
